



THE PELIAN ASH

Weapon (Spear), Rare (requires attunement)

Forged from the ash of Mount Pelion and carried by Achilles, this spear is an heirloom rather than a trophy. In the Iliad, Patroclus may wear Achilles' armour, but not bear this weapon. Its weight belongs to one life, one history, and one hand.

HEIRLOOM WEIGHT

You gain a +1 bonus to attack rolls and damage rolls made with this magic spear. A creature that is not attuned to the spear has Disadvantage on attack rolls made with it.

THE DECISIVE THROW (1/DAWN)

When you make a ranged attack with the spear, you can gain Advantage on the attack roll. On a hit, the target takes an extra 2d6 force damage, and the spear returns to your hand at the end of the turn.



RITE OF ATTUNEMENT

During a short rest, speak aloud the name of a person, place, or promise you refuse to abandon.

THE PRICE

After using The Decisive Throw, you cannot gain Temporary Hit Points until you finish a Long Rest.
